Spring 2019 Scoring Opportunity

The American Institutes for Research (AIR) and Measurement Incorporated (MI) are recruiting interested Indiana educators to be involved in the scoring process for the upcoming ILEARN assessment. Indiana educators will fill temporary Scorer positions during the spring 2019 scoring season to align with legislation requiring Indiana educators to support scoring to the extent possible.

Requirements:

- Currently employed as an educator at an accredited Indiana school
- Access to a computer/online device that meets the minimum technical requirements provided by MI, high-speed internet access, and a secure work area
- Demonstrate ability to apply scoring criteria as directed and maintain consistent and reliable scoring results throughout the project
- Willing to engage in a repetitive task situation and maintain confidentiality

ILEARN Scoring Window:

May 13 – June 6, 2019

Work Hours & Commitments:

- Teachers
 - **Evening Shift**
6:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. ET
 - **Required Commitment**
Three nights per week for three weeks
- Instructional Coaches
 - **Day Shift**
8:30 a.m. – 4:15 p.m. ET
 - **Required Commitment**
Three to four total days

Compensation:

- Hourly rate: \$11.70
- If educators score during the school day while under contract, their payment may be directed to their school corporations.
- If selected, educators will be asked to register in our payroll system and set up direct deposit for a bank account.
- Payments will be issued every other Friday for the preceding two-week pay period.
